Accelerated Budget Opt Out Resolution Certifying Tax Rate Within Inflation Index (and No Need to Comply with Act 1 Accelerated Budget Procedures) 2019-2020 School Year


RESOLVED, that the Board of School Director of Steel Valley School District, makes the following unconditional certifications:

1. The school district's various tax levies and other revenue sources will be sufficient to balance the school district final budget for the next fiscal year 2019-2020 based on maintaining current tax rates or increasing tax rates by an amount less than or equal to the Act 1 index applicable to the school district as calculated by the Pennsylvania Department of Education. This conclusion is based on the school district preliminary budget or other information available to the School Board.
2. The applicable index for the next fiscal year is 3.1% and the School Board will not for the next fiscal year increase the rate of its real estate tax, or any other tax for the support of public education, by an amount that exceeds the applicable index.
3. The School Board has to date and in the future will comply with the rules set forth in School Code 687 for adoption of the school district proposed and final budgets for the next fiscal year.
4. The School Board understands that the school district will not be eligible to use Act 1 referendum exceptions for the next fiscal year.



RESOLUTION NO. 190158

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SCHOOL DIRECTORS OF THE STEEL VALLEY SCHOOL DISTRICT, SUPPORTING THE BOROUGH OF WEST HOMESTEAD'S JUNIOR COUNCIL PERSON PROGRAM AND ENCOURGING THE PARTICPATION OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT AND ITS SUDENTS TO ENGAGE WITH THE WEST HOMESTEAD BOROUGH GOVERNMENT TO DEVELOP LEADERSHIP AND PUBLIC SPEAKING SKILLS, AND FOR THE BOROUGH OFFICIALS TO MENTOR FURTURE LEADERS IN THE COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, the Junior Council Person Program provides the West Homestead Students of the School District to engage with Borough officials to develop leadership skills; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of School Directors of the Steel Valley School District that cooperation between the Steel Valley School District and the Borough of West Homestead to develop the Junior Council Person Program is in the best interest of the public welfare of the Steel Valley Community.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of School Directors of the Steel Valley School District as follows:


SECTION 1. That the Board of School Directors of the Steel Valley School District hereby authorizes the Administrations of the School District to cooperate with the Borough of West Homestead to the extent allowed by law to aid the Borough of West Homestead in providing a Junior Council Person Program.

SECTION 2. Any resolutions that conflict with this resolution is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
