Director of Academics, Information & Technology

Mr. Colebank reported the schedule for the upcoming PSSA:

February 11 PSSA Writing Grades 5, 8 & 11

There will be no school for students on Friday, February 15, due to a teacher professional development day. The district will host classroom teachers from other school districts on February 14-15 for "Out of the Box" technology training sponsored by Apple Computer and the Department of Education. Steel Valley's science teachers involved in the *Classrooms For The Future* grant will also participate.

The district is in the beginning stages of making application for Middle States Accreditation by gathering data, creating a portfolio and surveying students, parents and the public. The district is collecting data through web surveys. There is one student survey, 13 parent surveys and 12 non-parenting household surveys on the Steel Valley website (www.svsd.k12.pa.us).

Mr. Colebank reported that he has been approached by Mr. William Campbell's associates to begin Phase 2 of the district technology plan. Phase 2 will have an emphasis on the secondary schools and academic improvement.

Director of Elementary Education

Dr. Policastro announced that the Queen of Hearts would be reading to the Franklin Primary students on February 6. WQED will be filming this session, and Dr. Policastro is hoping that Steel Valley receives the grant for next year. Mrs. Cannon thanked Dr. Policastro for acquiring the grant from WQED this school year.

At the February 15 inservice day, K-2 teachers will be learning Reading strategies and teachers in grades 3-5 will receive training on SuccessMaker.

Dr. Policastro reported that the K-5 science curriculum is available, and the teachers continue their work on the pacing guides.

Director of Pupil Personnel and Special Services

Educational Leadership
