## Student DropOff and PickUp

#### Dismissal

All students dismiss from left entrance at the front of the building

- 5th/6th grade dismiss at 3:15PM
- 7th/8th grade dismiss at 3:19PM

  - Arrival is normal time
  - Dismissal at 12:23PM

- Students will receive locker information from homeroom teacher




#### Lockers

Students will receive locker information from homeroom teacher

To ensure safety of personal belongings, students are required to have locks on their lockers

Students are not permitted to share lockers or store materials in another person's locker

An additional lock should be used for gym lockers




#### Cell Phones

## Progress Reports and Report Cards


Progress reports and report cards will each be distributed four times per academic year

Visitors must supply photo ID in order to enter the building


NO VISITORS are to report to any classroom without approval from the office
