Hello And Happy Valentines Day from Steel Valley Middle School. Here are the announcements for the week of February 14th.

A reminder that there will be no school on Monday, February 15th due to an Act 80 day for staff. Gold students will resume in-person instruction on Tuesday and Thursday this week. Maroon students will resume in-person classes on Wednesday. Live-Streaming students will report on their designated grouping day Maroon or Gold.

Live-streaming of classroom instruction will begin Tuesday, February 16. This means that live instruction will be available to our remote students through Zoom meetings of our hybrid in-person instruction. Students should access their Zoom meetings through links on Google Classroom.

On March 1, hybrid in-person instruction will end because in-person instruction will expand to four days a week, Monday through Thursday. We assume that most people who are doing in-person learning now will want to continue with the four-day in-person learning. Likewise, we assume that most people who are doing remote learning now will want to stay with the live-streaming option. However, if you wish to change the instructional model for your child for March 1, whether they would be moving from hybrid to remote or from remote to in-person, you must notify your child's school of your intention to do so by Friday, February 19, 2021.

An important reminder, that if school is called off for weather or other instances, all students will move to our synchronous remote via Zoom and follow their daily schedule.
